Eligibility

This professional development opportunity is to be filled from within WA Health by **permanent recruitment**. Current EMHS employees (including permanent and fixed term contract) are eligible to apply. EMHS strongly encourages applications from Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islanders, people from culturally diverse backgrounds and people with disabilities.

Position Description

Have you always wanted to work in the Intensive Care Unit but felt you lacked the experience and/or confidence to apply? If so, please read on.

This is an amazing and rare opportunity for permanent employment within the Intensive Care Unit and to participate in a fast tracked and well-supported training program. The purpose is to give Registered Nurses without ICU experience the opportunity to develop their critical care skills over a 12-week period, resulting in being able to safely and competently care for an ICU patient inclusive of invasive ventilation. You will work under close supervision for the duration of the program and will be supported by a team of Staff Development Nurses and senior nurses.

In order to complete the program, you are required to:

- a. commit to study
- b. successfully complete a comprehensive learning map including theoretical and practical assessment.
- c. pass a medication calculations test including critical care specific medications and calculations.
within week 1 of the program.

Pre reading will be supplied to successful candidates.
